Community Fit was developed by the Jarrahdale Community Collective to provide fitness classes to our community led by experienced local trainers. Classes commence July 21, 2020 for Term 3 (10 weeks) at The Jarrahdale Hub - Bruno Gianatti Hall

Registration is mandatory for each participant and can be done online or at your first class. Classes are drop in only (registration doesn't secure you a spot) we suggest participants arrive 15 mins early to secure a space (20 per class)

Adult Fit	Tuesdays 6pm - 7pm Men & Women 16+ Adult & Teen \$5, Senior 50+ \$2 Every session is different and goes over the 5 functional body movements. Sessions start with a movement warm up a workout and stretches to complete each class.
Flow Movement	Wednesdays 10am - 11am Men & Women 16+ Adult & Teen \$5, Senior 50+ \$2 This class is designed for flowing movements with no getting down on the floor. Best for people who may have injuries and balance issues for moving better every day.
Kids Fit	Wednesday 4pm - 5pm Youth 7-12 y/o Kids \$5 Super fun fitness focusing on increasing the heart rate, using all muscle groups and developing natural abilities.
Teen Fit	Wednesdays 5pm - 6pm Youth 13+ Teen \$5 Super fun fitness focusing on burning energy, and learning physical skills and functional movements while empowering youth and instilling healthy habits.
Yoga	Fridays 10am - 11am Men & Women 16+ Adult & Teen \$5, Senior 50+ \$2 Bring flexibility, strength and build a connection between your mind and body. This class encompasses yoga Asana (poses) and pranayama (breath) to help you move and stretch.
